Qualifications

- Be trained in the use of the low ropes challenge course (training will be offered by GSNNJ at no cost to you if you will be facilitating the challenge course on weekends in the spring and fall)
- Problem solving and communication skills
- Detail oriented person
- Desire to work in an outdoor camp setting
- Ability to work well with others
- Experience working with children
- Certified in first aid and CPR (may be able to certify through the council)
- Registered member of GSNNJ (must have current membership) with background check

General Responsibility

- Supervising and coordinating troop or group activities
- Keep site clean
- Enforce site procedures and maintain safety of all using the property
- Must be on site before troop/group arrives until they leave

Specific Responsibilities

Provide information and assistance to registered troops/groups

- Check troops/groups in at the challenge course
- > Be knowledgeable of council crisis management plan
- Enforce GSNNJ policies and procedures for use of challenge course
- Respond to emergency situations by providing first aid, directions to the hospital, or calling for police or fire
- Report accidents (or incidents) and complete reports (accident, incident, damage)
- Be knowledgeable about property conditions and applicable Girl Scout Safety Wise Standards
