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I agree that the following statements are true, and I will follow them. They will be in effect each time the Girl Scout Troop is together for any reason.

I WILL

Behave according to the Promise and Law, which includes and is not exclusive to the following:

- Be respectful of others. I will remember that others have ideas and thoughts, which may be different from mine, and that their ideas and thoughts are just as important as mine. I will not disparage the ideas and thoughts of others. I will try not to offend anyone else with my thoughts and ideas.
- Be respectful of authority. I will uphold the decisions of the troop, the Service Unit, GSNNJ, and GSUSA. I will follow instructions that are given to me to the best of my ability.
- Be considerate. I will treat others as I would like to be treated at all times.
- Be honest. I will be truthful at all times in what I say and do.
- **Be fair.** I will treat everyone equally.
- **Be helpful.** I will be supportive and do what I can to be useful to others.

- On my **3th offense**, my parent/guardian will be required to attend all troop meetings/events with me.
- On my 4th offense, I will be asked to leave the troop.
