With your camera:

- Take 6 macro photos of your yourself.
- Take 6 photos of objects that are all the same color.
- Take 3 portrait photos of different objects or people in your home and edit.
- Take 6 photos of someone in motion.

If possible, print out your favorite photos and make a photo frame.
