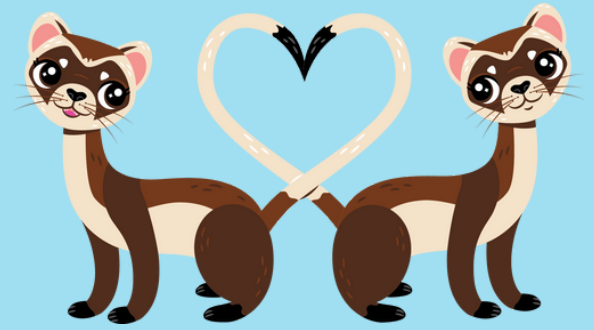
- Sell 50 items during the 2025 Fall Product Program
- Participate in a community service project between October 1 and April 12

Sell 500 packages of Girl Scout Cookies during the 2026 Girl scout Cookie Program.



Girl Scouts who do not meet the Fall Product Program requirements can still earn a week of camp by selling 600 packages of Girl Scout Cookies and participating in a community service project.

Phases of the Girl Scout Cookie Program



Initial Order Period

Jan. 9 - Feb. 8

- Girl Scouts take cookie orders through Digital Cookie or on the girl Scout Cookie order form.
- Digital Cookie is open for all order types: Girl-delivered, shipped, and donated.
- Parents/Caregivers enter off-line (Order Card) sales into Digital Cookie by Feb. 9.
- Troop Cookie Managers finalize the Troop Initial Order in eBudde and submit the order by Feb. 10

Post-Initial Order Period

Feb. 19-March 6

- In Digital Cookie, the girl-delivered option is paused. However, shipped and donated orders are still available.
- Troop Sites open in Digital Cookie on Feb.13.
- Trucks full of Girl Scout Cookies head to GSNNJ for Service Unit deliveries (Feb. 21 - March 1)

This is a perfect time to plan for your Booth Sale. Make decorations, finalize a schedule, and get ready to have fun!

Booth Sales and Additional Sales March 7 - April 12

- Digital Cookie girl- delivered option becomes available March 7 - April 6.
- Digital Cookie shipped and donated orders are available through April 12.
- GSNNJ Cookie Cupboards open February 23
- Booth Sales begin Saturday March 7!
- All girl Scouts can continue to sell cookies through April 12. Troop Cookie Managers should monitor extra inventory, and if needed, order additional inventory from a Cookie Cupboard to fill additional sales.

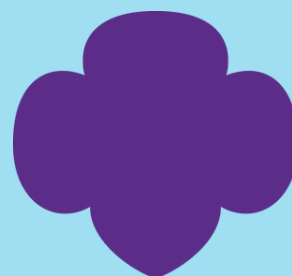
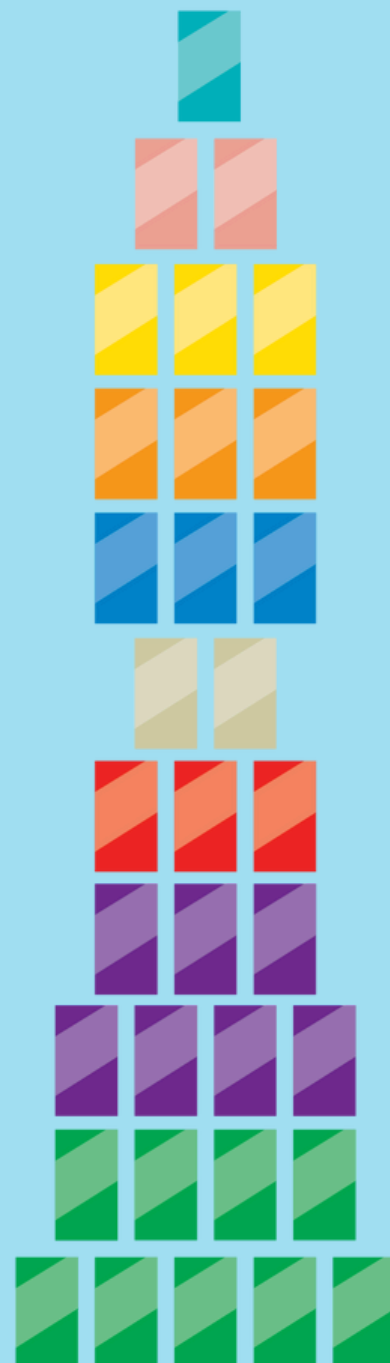
