Digital Cookie Shipping Promo

Happy Birthday Girl Scouts!
Let's celebrate with a \$6 flat fee shipping promo. Customers who order 7 to 12 packages of Girl Scout Cookies on March 12, 2026 will pay only \$6 in shipping costs.



In-Person Delivery Orders



Reminder: the in-person delivery option is available until April 7 in Digital Cookie. Follow the steps below to find and fill these orders for your Girl Scouts.

How to find an in-person delivery order (after the IO):

Look at the Girl Order tab in eBudde. If there is a Girl Scout with a negative dollar amount due, she most likely has received an in-person delivery order. Click on her name, then sort by “Girl Delivery after IO.”

How to fill the order:

If you have the cookies on hand, simply give them to the Girl Scout and add an order on her line so that the packages received equal the money credited to her. If you do not have these cookies on hand, you will need to place a Cookie Cupboard order for them. Once received, be sure to credit them to the girl so her totals even up.

Note: a Troop Volunteer must add the Cookie Cupboard order to eBudde but can designate anyone to pick them up.

It is important these orders are filled and credited properly. Your troop has been credited with the payment. The Girl Scout has been credited with the payment. The packages, however, are not credited until you do so in eBudde.

With just over 5 weeks left in the 2026 Girl Scout Cookie Program, now is a good time to check in with your Girl Scouts and discuss how close they are to meeting their goals. The Girl Order tab in eBudde is where you will find the most accurate sales totals by girl.

Have a Girl Scout who is super close to meeting their goal? Encourage them to send another round of Digital Cookie emails, ask friends and family to help them reach their goal, or host a goal-getting booth sale. Encourage them to be Brave. Fierce. Fun! and they will make their goal in no time.

Money Matters




The Initial Order payments will be processed via an ACH transaction the week of March 16. The amount due is for offline Initial Orders, less Troop Proceeds. The Troop Sales report in eBudde shows the amount due for this payment. Look for the line that reads “Initial Order Payment ACH.” If the amount is negative (-), your Troop does not owe anything at this time. If the amount is positive, this is what will be debited from your Troop Account.

Please make sure the bank account information listed in eBudde is correct. If you need to make changes, please submit a new ACH authorization form as soon as possible to avoid any payment issues.


