- Leave my area cleaner than I found it.

I will NOT:

- Get in the way of customers.
- Ask a customer more than once to buy cookies from me.
- Talk loudly, run around, play, or go into the store while selling at a booth sale.
- Eat, drink, or chew gum while at the booth sale.
