\*According to the Bylaws of the council Article 2, Section 2, the Committee shall present at the Annual Meeting a single slate of nominees for the five (5) elected Officers of the Council, for Members-at-Large of the Board of Directors (including Girl Members-at-Large), and for members of the Board Development Committee. The Committee shall develop and implement appropriate means of assessing the performance of the Officers, Board members, and its own members. Nomination for reelection as an Officer, Board Member-at-Large, or member of the Board Development Committee shall be based on evidence that such nomination is in the best interest of the Council.

At the Annual Meeting of the Council held the calendar year preceding the regular meeting of the National Council of Girl Scouts, the Board Development Committee shall present to the Voting Body a single slate of nominees for Delegates and Alternates to the National Council.

In accordance with the Bylaws of the council Article 1, Section 10, nominations may be made from the floor at the Annual Meeting provided that the eligibility of the individuals so nominated has been established and the written consent of such individuals has been secured and submitted, with their qualifications, to the Council Board Development Committee Chair by 5 p.m. on the day prior to the election date.
