Troop Proceeds Details:

- The Registered Per Girl Average (PGA) is calculated by dividing the total number of packages received by the number of registered girls.
- Troops in grades 6 and higher may decide together as a troop to opt out of earning rewards for higher proceeds.
- Troops in grades K-5 are not eligible to opt out of rewards.
- Keep up to date on your Troop's earnings by viewing the Troop Sales Report in eBudde.
- Please note: Proceeds are earned by Troops and should not be tracked individually by girls.
