Thank you for volunteering and for all you do. As you form your troop, here are some friendly reminders to help you get started:

Are all of your Girls and Troop Helpers registered?

Make sure every girl/adult participating in your troop is properly registered by viewing your troop roster in the Volunteer Toolkit (VTK).

Adults helping with the troop must be registered members with a current background check.

Have you explored the Volunteer Toolkit (VTK)?

Log in to your **MyGS** Account > VTK or My Troops menu to view your troop roster and contact caregivers as new girls join. The VTK is a customizable planning tool where you can set up the troop's calendar, find suggested meeting plans, access activity guides, badge requirements, and many helpful resources.

Have you completed New Leader Orientation (NLO)?

NLO is a training that is required for all new leaders starting or taking over a Girl Scout troop. Contact Customer Care at customercare@gsnnj.org for more information.
