- 3. Check Troop rosters and ensure that all girls are registered. Ensure all adult volunteers are registered with a current background check.
- 4. Troop leaders can view the roster and the background check expiration date in the VTK or under My Troops section of their MY GS account
- 5. We highly recommend to our Leaders to utilize the Girl and Parent/Guardian codes of conduct.
