

Each awardee must receive one nomination as well as the number of endorsements required (See Decision Chart).

The number of endorsements vary by award and must be submitted by different individuals. Although they may be brief, please be detailed and specific when writing the submissions.



Years of Membership Pin

GSNNJ also likes to acknowledge those adult volunteers who have been Girl Scouts for many years; these pins are awarded in 5-year increments (5, 10, 15, 20 or 25 + years).

- Years of Membership include total years as a registered member (both as a girl and as an adult) and are self-nominated and self-reported.
- Volunteers receiving these pins must be registered members for the current Girl Scout year.

Service Unit Managers may ask their volunteers for the information and then print & fill out the **Years of Membership Pin Application Form** which will soon be on our webpage. Please submit the completed form to: customercare@gsnnj.org

Note: 15 years and above, pins are presented at the Annual Meeting & Adult Recognition event, while 5 and 10-year pins are presented at the service unit level.

For Leaders: "Invite friends to join your troop"

Leaders can send friends an email invitation to join their troop from My Troops.

This link is only active for 60 minutes from the time it is sent. (In VS 2.0 Troop leaders cannot register new girls directly)

Included in the email is a unique one-time use link that sends the individual to the troop in the Participation Catalog for Membership registration.

- This unique link works only for the recipient you email it to, even if troop is not displayed or showing as having available spots.
- It is not sharable and will not work if pasted into another email or social media post.

Instructions: *Log in* to your **MyGS Account**

- 1. *Click* on **My Troop(s)** tab.
- 2. *Select* your Troop, to view membership roster
- *3. Scroll* to bottom of roster.
- 4. Click "Invite friends to join your troop"
- 5. Enter one parent/caregiver email.
- 6. "Submit Request." A confirmation message will appear as "Success! Your invite have been sent."

*Repeat step #4 for each individual invite.

January 16 SUMMIT Slide 1

Brooklyn Bridge & Sidewalks of New York: 5/5, 6/9/2024 – New York City, NY

• Start the day by walking across the Brooklyn Bridge as you begin your exploration of the southern tip of NYC. You'll be guided by our own historian as we venture into the very beginnings of the streets of New York. We'll head over to Trinity Church founded in 1697, the final resting place of Alexander Hamilton. Your trip around the southern tip includes multiple stops including the African Burial Ground National Monument, St. Paul's, and the 9/11 Memorial. Along the way, hear tales about our nation's start to its current global impact as we finish our walk on Wall Street. Fee includes coach bus transportation, professional guide, exclusive fun patch, and entrance to all venues. Bus pick-ups are tentatively scheduled for GSNNJ's Riverdale and Paramus Service Centers.

Philadelphia: Life and Liberty: 5/19/2024 – Philadelphia, PA

• Philadelphia, the City of Brotherly Love, is waiting for you to explore during this trip. You'll be walking in the steps of our country's history as you enter Independence Hall and stand where our founding fathers committed treason to the crown by signing the Declaration of Independence. Visit the National Constitution Center and explore our constitutional amendments and see a performance of "Freedom Rising." You'll eat lunch at the world-famous Reading Terminal. Finish the day at Eastern State Penitentiary, once the world's most famous and expansive prisons. Fee includes Coach Bus transportation, all tours and admissions, plus patch. There will be a lunch break which will not be included. Bus departs from Riverdale Service Center.

Salem: 6/22-6/23/2024 – Salem, MA

• Whether you are intrigued by the Salem Witch Trials or are a fan of the movie Hocus Pocus, this one-night adventure will satisfy your curiosities as we explore the historic town of Salem, Massachusetts. We'll visit famous sites such as "the House of the Seven Gables" and the Salem Heritage Trail during our walking tour with our personal historian and tour guide. Fee includes Coach bus transportation, hotel, breakfast, and two dinners.

Niagara Falls: Canada Style!: 7/28-7/31/2024 – Niagara Falls, Canada

• Get your passport and we'll head to the Canadian side of Niagara Falls. See the falls from your room as we stay at the Falls View Embassy Suites. Our hotel will be 100 yards from the brink! It's just a ten-minute walk to Niagara Falls or use the Incline Railway located directly behind the hotel, which will bring you right to the Canadian Horseshoe Falls. Explore Niagara Falls State Park. Discover the Cave of the Winds and enjoy the Maid of the Mist boat ride. You'll have an up-close view at night as the Falls are illuminated, and fireworks accent the sky. As an added treat, we'll have an early dinner at the Skylon Tower in its revolving restaurant! Trip includes coach bus transportation, hotel based on 4 or 2 persons per room.

Go Gold 1: The Introduction – Virtual – 2/1, 2/11, 2/28, 3/13, 3/25/2024

• This program is the first of the two required Girl Scout Gold Award trainings. You must attend this session before you begin, or are early into, your Journey work. An overview of the award, Journey strategies, timelines, and inspiration to get you started will be covered. This program is mandatory if you wish to pursue this prestigious award. Go Gold 2, The Project, must be attended after Journey completion (or near completion). NOTE: Adults only need to register if they are attending the session alone.

Go Gold 2: The Project – Paramus Service Center – 1/21, 3/12/2024 Riverdale Service Center – 3/24/2024

• This program is the second of the two required Girl Scout Gold Award trainings. You must attend this session once you have completed, or are near completing, your Journey work. You will learn the necessary elements of a successful Girl Scout Gold Award Take Action Project, how to construct your project, and how to navigate the council approval process. This program is mandatory if you wish to propose a Take Action Project to council. Go Gold 1 - The Introduction is a pre-requisite to this program. Adult members and non-members are welcome, but they must register to reserve a seat. Refunds are not available for this program, but efforts will made to reschedule.

Silver Award Workshop – Virtual – 3/19, 5/2/2024

• This optional, but highly recommended, workshop is open to parents and troop leaders who are interested in learning more about the Girl Scout Silver Award and strategies for helping the girls take the lead. Requirements will be reviewed, step by step, with plenty of time for questions. The new materials and review process will be presented, that is fully implemented as of Oct. 1, 2023.

Silver Quest – Paramus Service Center – 1/21, 3/12/2024 Riverdale Service Center – 3/19/2024

• At this girls-only program, we will explore the role of the Girl Scout Journeys, the Girl Scout Silver Award project steps, and the new approval process that is fully implemented as of Oct. 1, 2023. Once completed, you'll leave empowered to take the lead and Take Action to make a difference in your community.

Bronze Award Workshop – Virtual - 3/5/, 5/13/2024

• This optional, **but highly recommended**, workshop is open to parents and troop leaders who are interested in learning more about the Girl Scout Bronze Award. Requirements will be reviewed, step by step, with plenty of time for questions.






